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Pre/Post Natal/Family Health Promotion/Education Projects

Brief description:

- DHE's provide oral screenings and fluoride varnish to children 0-5 yrs of age at preschools, schools, daycares, Hutterite colonies, public health clinic sites, Kid's First, Head Start programs and parenting groups. Dental health education is provided with parents/caregivers. Children with treatment needs are referred to a dental office.
- PHN's provide oral assessments at CHC's and refer children to the DHE for fluoride varnish & counseling.
- Post natal oral health packages are provided to new parents at the Moose Jaw Union Hospital. (average 60 per month)

Follow-up with families of children receiving dental treatment under General Anesthesia

Brief description:

- GA follow-ups are provided by the DHE's. Dental screening, fluoride varnish and oral health education/resources are offered to the family.

Adult & Seniors Health Promotion/Education/Projects

Brief description:

- Adult/Senior referrals to DHE from local GP Doctors and Home Care Nurses.
- Adults/Seniors receive oral health assessments, counseling, and education/resources. Oral care plans provided.
- During National Oral Health Month "Meals on Wheels" clients receive dental care/resource pkgs.
