

Public Health Ontario- Oral Health Snapshot

Public Health Ontario launched “Oral Health Snapshot”, a new interactive data tool. This tool will help you make sense of trends in behaviours and outcomes related to oral health in your region. This will help inform public health decision-making and planning.

Snapshots is a suite of tools using maps, charts and tables to help you compare public health unit and provincial data, and identify trends over time. Oral Health Snapshot uses data from the Canadian Community Health Survey, which includes self-reported data for individuals aged 12 and older. This provides access to statistics and information related to oral health for Ontario and its 36 public health units.
